



Funk in the City Art Festival @ Haynie's Corner has been around for over 15 years, we have two Art Festivals one in the Spring and one in the Fall. The Spring Art Festival is in its 9th year and the Fall Art Festival is in its 16th year.

Funk in the City, Inc. is a local volunteer-driven organization with the mission of providing unique and artistic events and festivals for the tristate area. Since its founding over ten years ago, Funk in the City has strategically grown its events to attract thousands of festivals goers from around the region and across the country.

What We Do With The Proceeds - a portion of them will go towards a project or needs of the Haynie's Corner Arts District.

This year we are going to change our application process as we are going to go to a juried show, below will outline how this process will work and please if you have any questions let us know.

### **Eligibility**

All artwork must be original and created by the artist. Prints are permitted but must be clearly marked as a reproduction. Commercial exhibits, buy and sell items, items made from kits and commercially molded articles are not permitted.

### **Jury Process**

Juror decisions are based 80% upon the quality of work portrayed in the images submitted for the jury process, and 20% on your booth presentation. If you do not submit a booth image you will automatically lose 3 points off your final score. Your booth image should not have the artist or any signage with the artist name or business name visible and should represent the setup we will actually see at the event. **We are requiring 5 images including a booth image.**

### **Categories**

- **Ceramics:** Original shaped and fired clay (including earthenware, porcelain, stoneware and terra-cotta)
- **Digital Art:** This category includes any original work for which the original image or the manipulation of a source material is executed but the artist using a computer. Photographs taken through a digital camera should apply in the PHOTOGRAPHY category.
- **Drawing:** Works created using such dry media as chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencils and wax crayon or from the fluid medium of inks and washes applied by pen or brush are to be entered into this category.
- **Fiber:** All work created from fibers including basketry, embroidery, weaving, leatherwork, tapestry, and paper making. No factory-produced wearable items, regardless of additional modifications or enhancements by the artist may be exhibited.

- **Glass:** Original work created in glass by the artist including blown glass, fused glass or stained glass.
- **Jewelry:** All jewelry, whether the work is produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic or other materials must be entered in this category. No commercial casts, molds, or production studio work allowed.
- **Metalwork:** Includes all non-sculptural, non-jewelry works crafted from metal. No production studio work is allowed.
- **Mixed Media:** This category includes works, both 2D and 3D, that incorporates more than one type of physical material to produce. Includes non-sculptural work as determined by the artist. Jewelry is not considered mixed media; jewelry must apply in the JEWELRY category. Photography is not considered mixed media; photography must apply in PHOTOGRAPHY category.
- **Painting:** Works created using such materials as oils, acrylics and watercolor, are in this category. Reproductions are allowed.
- **Photography:** Photographic prints made from the artist's original image which have been processed by the artist or under their direct supervision, are included in this category. Images printed through software such as Photoshop are to be entered into this category.
- **Sculpture:** Three-dimensional original work done in any medium.
- **Wood:** Original works that are hand-tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved are accepted in the wood category.

Artists may display work only in the media categories in which they are accepted. All work exhibited must be comparable to work shown in the submitted images.

### **Festival Policies**

1. Acceptance is non-transferable.
2. All festivals are drug-free. No smoking is allowed in or near artists' booths
3. Accepted artist must be present during festival hours. No agents, representatives, family members or friends are permitted as a substitute for the accepted artists' attendance, unless express exception is granted in certain circumstances.
4. Any artist closing the booth prior to the end of the show without permission will not be permitted to return in future years. If it is weather related there are exceptions.
5. Only artwork in the category accepted through the jury process is allowed.
6. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting and remitting local sales tax to the State's Department of Revenue as required by law.

### **Exhibit Space**

Spaces are 10'X10' and work must be contained within the assigned space. You may not infringe on another space physically or audibly. Only one artist's work or the work of two approved collaborating artists may be displayed per booth. If a shared booth both artists have to submit images. Artist must keep their area clean and orderly. Double spaces are considered and must be occupied by two tents.

During the festival, all booths will be visited by a festival representative to ensure that they are in compliance with our festival policies. It is the exclusive right and responsibility of the organizers of the festival to call for the removal of work that is not in compliance with the festival policies

and requirements. Noncompliance may result in expulsion from the festival or refusal of future festival participation.

### **Festival Information/ Artist Amenities**

- Volunteer Support: We will have volunteers to assist artist loading in and loading out.
- Ample off-street parking close to the Art Festival during the show
- Curb side unloading and loading
- Complimentary bottled water for artists
- Complimentary breakfast will be provided from 7:00am-8:30am

### **Artist Description**

Each artist needs to give a 10-15 word description about what they will be showing at their booth for the map and website.

### **Wait List Policy**

A wait list is selected from the jury's scores in each category, and wait listed artists are invited as cancellations occur in that particular category. Wait list artists can be accepted up to and on the day of the show and will be notified by phone and email when a booth becomes available.

### **Cancellation Policy**

Any jury or booth space fees will be non refundable.

### **No Show Policy**

Artist who have not checked in at the Information Booth by 9:30 am Saturday morning will be considered a NO SHOW and the assigned space will be forfeited with no refund.

### **Rain Date**

Funk in the City Art Festival @ Haynie's Corner takes place rain or shine. There will be no rain date and fees will not be refunded in case of inclement weather. No refunds

### **Artist Agreement**
